The Meeting House Family of Churches Inc. (referenced to in this privacy policy as "The Meeting House", "we", "us", and "our") is the sole owner and operator of this site. This Privacy Policy applies to The Meeting House website (located at www.themeetinghouse.com) and governs data collection and usage.

The Meeting House knows that you care how information about you is used and shared, and we appreciate your trust that we will do so carefully and sensibly. We have established this Privacy Policy so that you can understand how we use and protect your Personal Information. "Personal Information" means any information that may be used to identify an individual, including, but not limited to, a first and last name, a home or other physical address, an e-mail address, or other contact information, whether at work or at home. By visiting any of The Meeting House's websites, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

Information Collection and Use

We will not sell, share, or rent this information to others in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement. The Meeting House collects information from our users at several different points on our website to operate The Meeting House website, and deliver the services you have requested.

We keep track of the pages our users visit within The Meeting House website, in order to determine what The Meeting House services are most popular.

Cookies

A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's hard drive containing information about the user. The Meeting House does not store any cookies with any personal private information. If a user of this website specifies a preferred site location (Oakville or High Park etc.) for calendar, event, home church, or teaching filters, a cookie will be stored on the user's computer with only their preferred site selection.

We encourage our users to be aware when they leave our site and to read the privacy statements of each and every web site that collects personally identifiable information. This privacy statement applies solely to information collected by this web site.

Security

This website takes every precaution to protect our user's information. All personal information about our members is stored only on computer systems at The Meeting House Production Facility in Oakville, Ontario, or at cloud services used to collect information or manage volunteers. Correction/Updating Personal Information and Retention of Information
