Role

The kidmax Intern will work with the Oakville Kids Ministry Pastors to learn the ins and outs of children's ministry in a large church environment. This individual will meet on a regular basis with the Cross Regional Kids Pastor for training, feedback, and encouragement. The goal of this internship is to provide practical ministry experience and intentional leadership development opportunities in several contexts at The Meeting House.

Requirements

- Exemplify the leadership character qualities listed in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Galatians 5:22-23
- Fully aligned with the message, mission and ministry strategy of The Meeting House
- Excellent organizational and relational skills
- Strong computer skills in MS Office and social media
- Experience in children's ministry is an asset
- Enrolled in a ministry, teaching or related diploma or degree program
- Fully security cleared by The Meeting House
- *Based on Canada Summer Jobs criteria, the kidmax Intern must be an active student between ages 18-30, and priority will be given to students who are of visible minority, member of the Indigenous community and/or have a disability*

Responsibilities

- **Sunday Mornings**
 - Intern will attend the Oakville site, having opportunity to lead in a variety of classrooms or shadow a staff member, gaining experience in working with children from birth to grade 5. Occasionally, Intern may be asked to act in a Coordinator role (for Preschool or Gr. 1-5) to cover for a staff member on vacation.
- **Plan and Lead 2 Oakville kidmax family events**
 - Work with Oakville kidmax staff to plan 2 summer events for families of the Oakville site.
- **Work alongside Site Support Team 1 day a week**

- Work with our Site Support team to learn how our sites are resourced for kidmax (classroom supplies, curriculum packing, etc.)
- **Work alongside Curriculum Team 1 day a week**
 - Work with our Curriculum Team to learn how our kidmax curriculum is developed (writing team, video shoots, research, etc.)
- **Help to prepare for the 2019-2020 ministry year, fall kick-off, etc.**
 - Work with Kids Pastor to develop training tools for fall launch
 - Work with Oakville kidmax staff to prepare for fall launch
